A competitive event, the Woodstock Film Festival awards cash and in-kind prizes in a variety of categories, including Saturday night's popular "Maverick Awards." This year's star-studded event will take place on October 10 - 14, in the towns of Woodstock, Rhinebeck, Kingston, Rosendale and Saugerties.
